**J. Robert Arkbush Award - presented in recognition of outstanding social action/interfaith programming.** Organized by your Brotherhood, to bring about better understanding of other faiths within your Temple; or to educate other faiths and better relationships within the Jewish Community.

Jerome Siegel Award - in recognition of outstanding Men's Only Programming. A program organized by your Brotherhood for Men Only. This program should be about better communication and bonding of men, not just a program that excludes women.

Morton Kemper Intergenerational Award - in recognition of outstanding intergenerational Achim corps programming. A program that promotes interaction, communication, bonding and learning between various generations and ages of participants.

**Dr. Alan Gardner Award - in recognition of outstanding youth, teen or college programming.** A program to help, support and educate the younger members of the Temple Community, or the Community in general.

Irving Richman Award - in recognition of outstanding Adult Jewish Educational **Programming.** A program organized to support Adult Jewish Education.

**Stuart Aaronson Award - in recognition of Outstanding General Programming.** Any program organized by your Brotherhood that would not fit into any of the above categories.
